Have you heard the story "xwaašxwiipši^{*}" (She Turned Into a Blue Jay)? We can learn different words about family and nature as the little boy learns his lesson.

Activity #1: Landscape Drawing

What lessons can we learn from appreciating the beauty of the land?

Think of a place on the land around your community that is special to you. You can also picture a natural landscape in your imagination.

In the space below, draw a sketch of this landscape and the animals who might live there. Label each natural feature that you draw in nuučaanuł.
